## Introduction To The Teaching Profession – 24 Hour Program

Applying for a Certificate of Eligibility? Here is your first step. New Pathways to Teaching in New Jersey (NPINJ) is pleased to offer the new 24-Hour Program required for Alternate Route candidates who apply for a Certificate of Eligibility (CE).

This course is a prerequisite of the NJ Department of Education for all CE applications received after October 30, 2009. **NOTE:** Individuals whose CE applications are received by the DOE prior to October 31, 2009 are not required to take this course.

This non-credit course consists of 20 hours of class work and 4 hours of classroom observation. Course content includes:

- An Overview of the Teaching Profession
- Classroom Management
- Assessment Tools
- Lesson Plans
- Learning Strategies
- Job Search Strategies for Teachers
- Diversity in the Classroom
- Implementation of Technology
- Classroom Observation

Upon successful completion, students will receive a certificate, as required by the NJ Department of Education, which documents their program completion. The certificate must be included in their CE application packet. Bring your own lunch. No food is available on campus on Saturdays.
