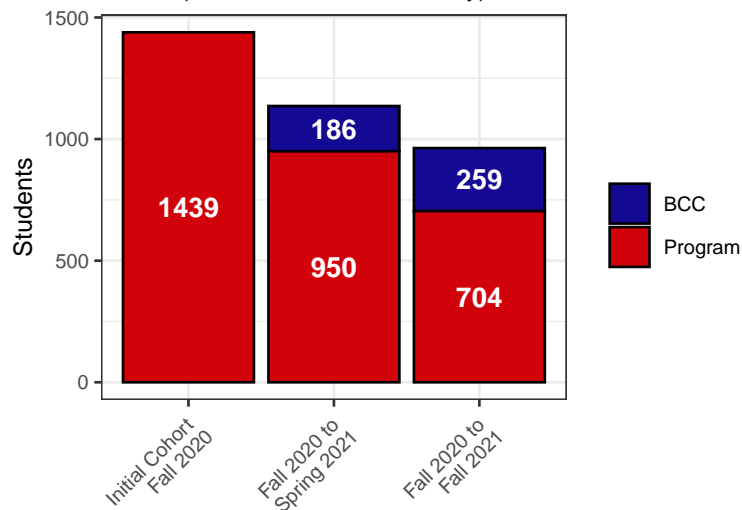
Enrollment by Age in Fall 2021



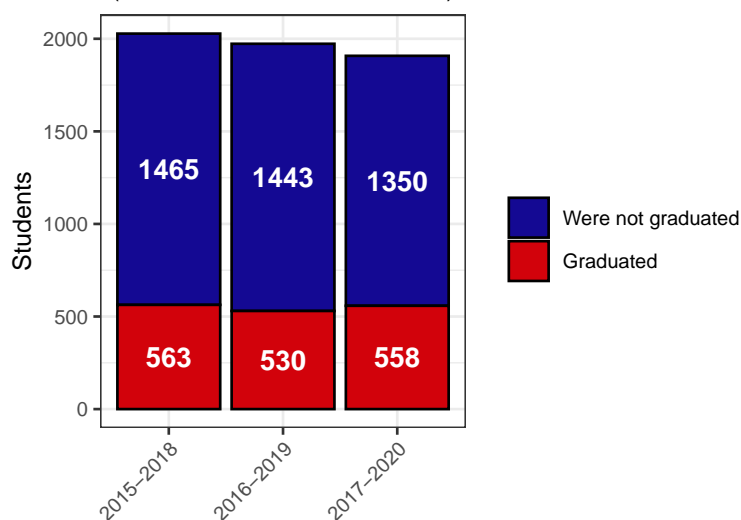

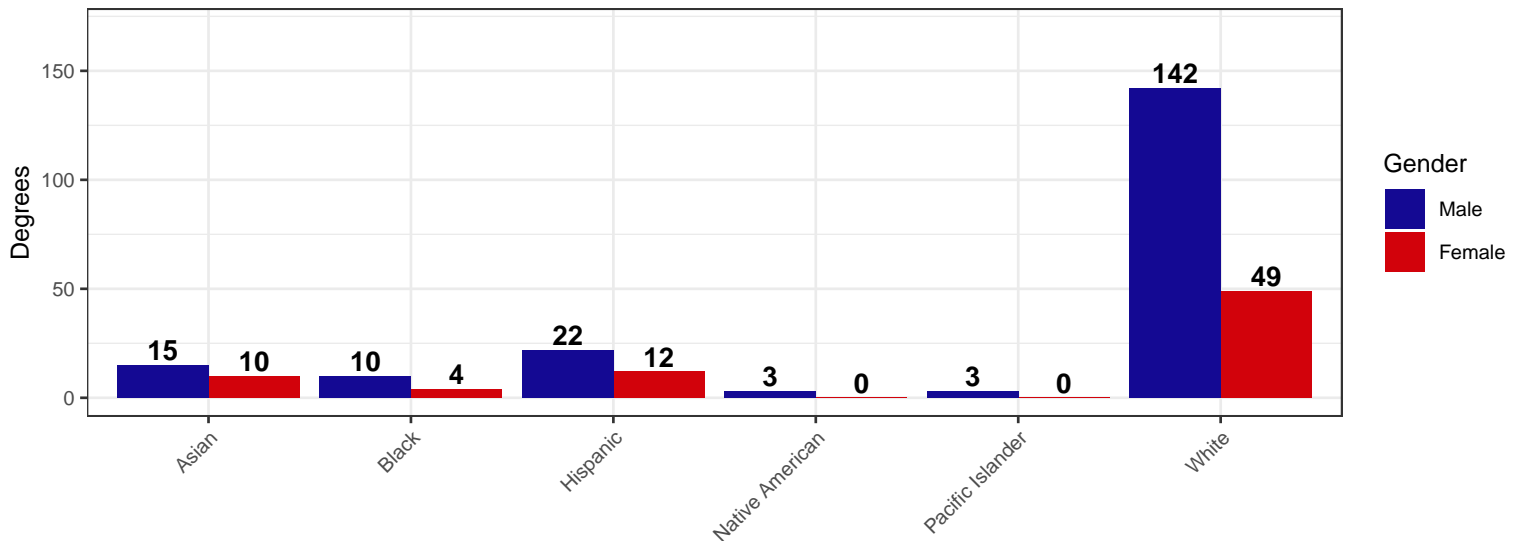
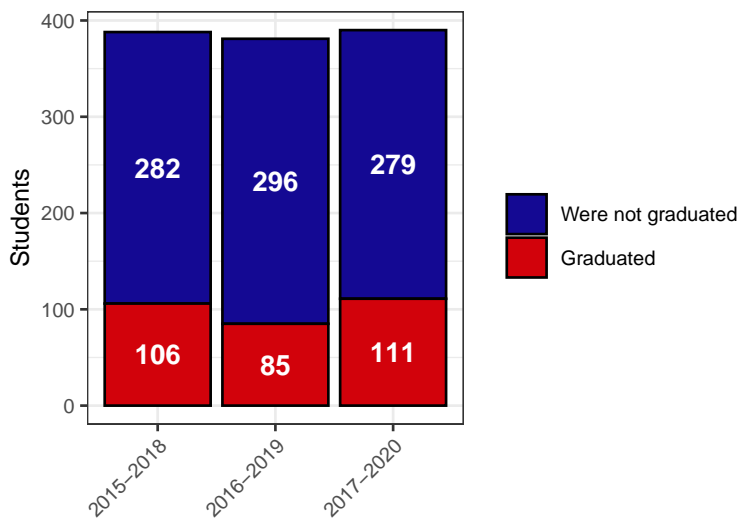
Enrollment by Age in Fall 2021
