- A As of Fall 2014 the Department of Teacher Education has added a foreign language requirement of 3 credits to the Education curriculum.

- Students are required to select a second major in a Liberal Arts Discipline
- > Middle School & Early Childhood Education disciplines are classified as a Minor at Rider University.
- > Brookdale students interested in the College of Continuing Studies (CCS) at Rider should contact that division directly.
- As of September 1, 2015 The New Jersey Department of Education requires students to take and pass all sections of Praxis The Core Academic Skills for Educators Test (Test Code: 5751) prior to formal entry into a teacher preparation program.
- For transfer the Brookdale student must earn a grade of C or higher in all courses.
